



Certificate IV in Training & Assessment - New Requirements after April 1 2019

What's it all about?

The Certificate IV in Training and Assessment is the minimum requirement to work as a Facilitator/ Assessor within the VET (Vocational Education and Training) sector. Time Education & Training can support individuals who currently hold the TAE40110 to complete the two (2) new core units required as of April 1 2019.

The two units that will be required are:

- TAELLN411: Address Adult Language, Literacy and Numeracy Skills (or the superseded TAELLN401A) &
- TAEASS502: Design and Develop Assessment Tools (or the superseded TAEASS502B or TAEASS502A)

This information applies to current/ recent trainers/ assessors who hold a full TAE40110. Holders of skill sets or prior training and assessment qualifications such as the TAA40104 will have additional upgrade requirements. These additional requirements will vary depending on electives completed and recent experience within the VET sector. Holders of older or partial qualifications are encouraged to contact us to discuss their specific requirements.
