What do I need before I start?

Entry to this qualification is open to individuals who hold a CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care, or CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care.

Alternatively, individuals may hold an Australian diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care, or an Australian diploma or certificate III in Children's Services AND demonstrate at least 12 months of cumulative employment (full-time equivalent) within the last 5 years in a regulated education and care service in Australia, supported by verifiable evidence, or hold the CHCSS00147 Entry into Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care.

Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is available to all clients. This process formally recognises those skills and/or qualifications that the applicant already holds. It is an evidence collection process that recognises the competency of the applicant against the skill and knowledge requirements as determined by each relevant unit. Our team can support an applicant through understanding and applying for RPL prior to commencement of the qualification should they believe they may be eligible.
