



Upgrade to TAE40122 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment

What's it all about?

The new Standards for Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) have been designed with a focus on quality outcomes for learners and industry. This includes ensuring that those delivering and assessing are adequately *"qualified, skilled and committed to professional development"* and that they have *"current skills and knowledge in training and assessment."*

While it is not currently mandatory for Facilitators to hold the TAE40122 version of the Certificate IV in Training and Assessment, upgrading to this qualification will assist participants and their employers in providing evidence of meeting the Standards. It will also provide an opportunity to refresh and develop your knowledge and skills in this area.

Who should do this qualification?

This upgrade program is ideal for those who are currently working within a Registered Training Organisation (RTO), enterprise, community organisation, school or other VET provision context. It may also be suitable for those who are not currently working in these roles but who have experience within these contexts.

Program Delivery

The Upgrade to the TAE40122 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment Program is delivered via a face-to-face class program.

Note - Depending on your previous academic records, you may be required to undertake an additional unit. If so, this will be undertaken via Distance Learning under the guidance and mentorship of a Specialist Facilitator.
